H Ocean View: (Handicap accessible cabins available on a first come, first served basis)	\$963.11* per person, based on double occupancy. Ocean View cabins have a window, but no balcony. Call us for rates on triple or quad occupancy.
M Inside: (Handicap accessible cabins available on a first come, first served basis)	\$813.11* per person, based on double occupancy. Inside cabins are full sized, but have no window. Call us for rates on triple or quad occupancy.
